### Notes:

Northwest Missouri State is in its third Elite Eight since 2017 and has won the Division II title in its previous two, beating Fairmont State in 2017 and Point Loma in 2019. ... The Bearcats, who have a record of 154-8 since that first national title season, lead the nation in field goal percentage at 53.7 percent while also ranking third in three-point shooting (42.7 percent) and

seventh at the free throw line (80 percent). ... Ryan Hawkins had 32 points (11-14 from field, 6-8 from three) in the quarterfinal win over West Liberty for his seventh game with at least 30 points this season. ... Trevor Hudgins, the most outstanding player at the 2019 Elite Eight, scored 27 points in the second half and overtime in the Central Regional final to help the Bearcats erase an 11-point deficit with 3:01 remaining. ... The Bearcats have won their last seven games played at the Elite Eight.

### Notes:

Flagler continued its season of firsts with its quarterfinal win over Truman State -- first team to reach the Elite Eight in its NCAA Tournament and now first to make the semifinals in its inaugural appearance since Lynn in 1997. ... The Saints have won their last 16 games; their other two wins came over Division I Central Michigan and North Florida in December. ... The

Saints have held opposing teams to 39.4 percent shooting, the seventh-best mark in Division II. ... Jaizec Lottie, named Player of the Year in the Peach Belt Conference, is the nation's seventh-leading scorer with an average of 24.9 points per game; he had 29 in the win over Truman and has eight 30-point game of the season. ... Chris Metzger is second in the nation in field goal percentage at 72.3 percent. ... Flagler is the first semifinalist from the Peach Belt Conference since USC Aiken in 2014.
