



National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2024-25 Rankings – Dec. 10, 2024 (Poll #4)

Four of the final 10 remaining undefeated teams at the NCAA Division II level head up this week's NABC/Division II rankings, with those four teams – Nova Southeastern, West Texas A&M, Washburn and West Liberty – holding onto the spots they held last week at the top of the poll. Nine of the 10 unbeaten are part of this week's top 25.

Last week's fifth-ranked team, DBU, lost Friday to Lubbock Christian to allow Ferris State to move into the top five, as the Bulldogs have won 10 straight games following its opening game loss to West Texas A&M. MSU Moorhead and Daemen also moved up one spot apiece, while Fairmont State vaulted into the top 10 at No. 8 ahead of North Georgia and fellow top 10 newcomer Colorado School of Mines.

Hillsdale and Point Loma rejoined the rankings this week, while MSU Denver makes its first appearance of the season at No. 23.
