

National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2023-24 Rankings – Dec. 12, 2023 (Poll #4)

For the fourth straight week, Nova Southeastern was a unanimous selection as the top-ranked team in the NABC/Division II rankings, but after a week in which 13 teams suffered losses – including six of the top 10 – the new poll has had a significant shakeup with three new teams entering the top five and five additional teams making their first appearance of the season in the top 25.

MSU Moorhead rose to second after the second, third and fourth-ranked teams all lost games last week, while Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference rival Minnesota State jumped into the top five at No. 3. West Georgia also moved up into the fourth spot, as did West Texas A&M to No. 5.

The new teams in the rankings this week are Gannon at No. 18 as it makes its first appearance in the coaches' poll since Feb. 19, 2013; St. Thomas Aquinas at No. 19, Angelo State at No. 20, Converse at No. 22 and Winona State at No. 24, who also returns to the rankings for the first time since Jan. 28, 2014. In the case of Converse, the Valkyries are in the rankings for the first time since the program began three seasons ago.
