Weekly Poll Notes:

The top three spots held firm this week in the new NABC/Division II men's basketball rankings as Lubbock Christian, Nova Southeastern – the only two remaining undefeated teams in NCAA Division II – and Cal State San Bernardino remain at the top of the rankings.

Lubbock Christian won a pair of road games, including one over an Angelo State team that received votes this week, to stay perfect at 19-0. Nova Southeastern kept its unblemished record intact with two wins of its own heading into a showdown this week with No. 22 Barry.

Only two other teams in Division II have one loss in No. 3 Cal State San Bernardino – who will face No. 10 Chico State this weekend – and No. 6 UNC Pembroke, who avenged its only loss of the season Saturday with a 21-point win over Emmanuel for its 14th straight victory.

Northwest Missouri State rose one spot to No. 4 after last week's fourth-ranked team, Indiana (Pa.), suffered a loss that dropped the Crimson Hawks to eighth, while West Liberty returned to the top five as it extended its winning streak to four games.

Minnesota Duluth and Chico State returned to the top 10 this week, while Dominican (N.Y.) also rejoined the top 25 after falling out a week ago.

The California Collegiate Athletic Association has three teams among the top 10 this week, while the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference has three teams in the rankings in UMD, Augustana and Upper Iowa.
