2023-24 Rankings – Feb. 6, 2024 (Poll #11)

West Texas A&M stays atop the NABC/Division II coaches poll for the third week in a row after recording a pair of road wins last week, but now faces its first test as the top-ranked team away from home in the upcoming week. The Buffaloes will head to UT-Permian Basin and then to Angelo State, who has a 23-game winning streak on its home floor that is currently the second-longest in NCAA Division II.

Last week's second-ranked team, Minnesota State, suffered a road loss at Minnesota Duluth but remains in the top five in the fifth spot. Nova Southeastern, Fort Lewis and DBU all moved up a spot as a result, while MSU Moorhead and Colorado Mesa both returned to the top 10 this week after North Georgia, West Georgia and Gannon. Charleston also returned to the rankings following its win at West Liberty on Saturday as did Minnesota Duluth.
