Weekly Poll Notes:

Each of the top 11 spots went unchanged in the latest NABC/Division II rankings, which is headed by Northwest Missouri State for the third straight week. The Bearcats, winners of 14 consecutive games, are followed in the top five again this week by Lincoln Memorial, West Texas A&M, UC San Diego and Nova Southeastern.

The first change in the rankings came at No. 12, as St. Thomas Aquinas moved up two spots to that position. The biggest jumps this week were made by Dixie State and Cal State San Bernardino, both of whom rose seven spots in the rankings this week.

The Lone Star Conference and Sunshine State Conference have two teams apiece in the top 10 for the fourth straight week, with West Texas A&M and St. Edward's as the representatives from the LSC and Nova Southeastern and Florida Southern from the SSC.

Four teams from outside last week's top 25 made the rankings this week, including two in the poll for the first time this season. UNC Pembroke, who is tied for 20th, is ranked in the coaches poll for the first time in nearly a year and Lee is ranked for the first time in program history in the coaches' poll as a Division II member.

A total of 16 conferences have teams ranked in this week's top 25 with no conference having more than two teams in the rankings.

Earlier this season, West Liberty's record run of 149 consecutive weeks in the rankings came to an end. The team that took over the mantle of the longest active streak, Bellarmine, has seen its run end at 90 straight weeks after losing twice last week. The new active holder of the longest run of weeks as a ranked team is Northwest Missouri State at 66 straight weeks; West Texas A&M is next on the list at 44 in succession.
