Weekly Poll Notes:

The same 11 teams are atop the new NABC/Division II rankings – only in a slightly different order as a result of Florida Southern's 102-96 win Saturday over Nova Southeastern. That win moved Florida Southern to No. 5 in the new rankings and dropped Nova Southeastern to 10th, with the four teams in between all moving up a spot and Bridgeport holding at No. 11.

Northwest Missouri State, which extended its winning streak to 16 games last week, heads the poll for the fourth consecutive week and Lincoln Memorial, who owns the nation's longest winning streak at 25 games, is second in the new rankings.

With Rogers State making the top 25 in the coaches poll for the first time as a member of NCAA Division II, the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association has three teams in this week's rankings along with the California Collegiate Athletic Association, as Cal Poly Pomona also returned to the top 25 this week.

The Lone Star Conference and Sunshine State Conference have two teams apiece in the top 10 for the fifth straight week, with West Texas A&M and St. Edward's as the representatives from the LSC and Nova Southeastern and Florida Southern from the SSC.

In addition to Rogers State and Cal Poly Pomona, Indianapolis returned to the top 25 this week at No. 19 and Seattle Pacific entered the rankings for the first time this season at No. 20; the Falcons have won 19 of their last 20 games after an 0-4 start to the campaign.

A total of 15 conferences have teams ranked in this week's top 25, which comes out one day prior to the release of the first NCAA Division II regional rankings of the 2019-20 season.
