2024-25 Rankings – Feb. 18, 2025 (Poll #13)

Daemen completed last week as the last remaining undefeated team in NCAA Division II and as a result, has moved into the top spot in the NABC/Division II rankings for the first time in program history. The Wildcats, who are 23-0 on the season, have two regular season games remaining before the East Coast Conference Tournament and NCAA East Regional.

The Wildcats reached No. 1 after Washburn dropped a pair of road games last week and dropped to fourth as a result. The setbacks also allowed Nova Southeastern – who did receive four first place votes – to move up to second and Alabama Huntsville to third. DBU remained at No. 5 this week, but the rest of the top 10 was shuffled with Lincoln Memorial, Colorado School of Mines, West Liberty, Valdosta State and Columbus State now occupying those spots.

Four teams that received votes last week moved into the top 25 this week and three are making their first appearance of the season – No. 21 Lubbock Christian, No. 22 Michigan Tech and No. 23 Winona State. Chico State, who had been ranked earlier in the year, returns to the rankings.
