



National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2023-24 Rankings – Feb. 20, 2024 (Poll #13)

For the fifth straight week, West Texas A&M is atop the NABC/Division II coaches poll as it extended its winning streak to 21 with two victories last week and heads a poll where the top three spots remain the same for the third week in a row.

Nova Southeastern is ranked second again this week, followed by Fort Lewis in third, DBU in fourth and Minnesota State in fifth. The first change came again at No. 4, where a loss by DBU moves Minnesota State up to fourth and brings Gannon into the top five for the first time this season. The rest of the top 10 is completed by Colorado Mesa, Northwest Missouri State, DBU, California (Pa.) and West Georgia.

The only new teams to join the rankings this week were West Liberty, who returned to the rankings at No. 20 and UNC Pembroke, who appeared at No. 25
