

National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2022-23 Rankings – Feb. 21, 2023 (Poll #13)

As the final week of regular season play has arrived, Nova Southeastern – the lone undefeated team in NCAA Division II – retains the top spot in the NABC/Division II men's basketball rankings with a pair of teams that reached the national semifinals lurking right behind the Sharks.

Nova Southeastern will take a 25-0 record into the final week before the Sunshine State Conference Tournament begins, but two losses by last week's second-ranked team, Black Hills State – has vaulted three-time defending national champion Northwest Missouri State to No. 2 and Indiana (Pa.) to the third spot. Indianapolis rose to No. 4, the highest ranking for the Greyhounds since the 2014-15 season, while Fort Lewis – the team that handed Black Hills State both of its losses a week ago – jumped over Point Loma into the fifth spot. The three longest winning streaks in NCAA Division II are held by teams among the top six in the nation, with Nova Southeastern's run at 25 games, Point Loma's at 20 and Indianapolis sporting an 18-game winning streak heading into the week.

The conference tournament season gets underway on Feb. 21 with the start of the Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association and Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference events; the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Tournament is slated to get started on Saturday. The NCAA will release its second set of regional rankings on Wednesday, Feb. 22.
