2024-25 Rankings – Feb. 25, 2025 (Poll #14)

Daemen survived in an overtime contest last week against D'Youville and retains the top position in the NABC/Division II poll for the second week in a row, but the gap between the Wildcats and Nova Southeastern for No. 1 narrowed as well, as just three points separate the top two teams in this week's ranking.

Nova Southeastern got five first place votes to stay at No. 2, while Alabama Huntsville and Washburn each went 2-0 in the past week and stayed in the third and fourth positions, respectively. However, losses by DBU and Lincoln Memorial last week shook up the next few spots, with Colorado School of Mines moving up to its highest position of the season as it rose to No. 5.

West Liberty also moved up two spots to sixth and Columbus State rose from 10th to seventh, while Missouri S&T also made a three-spot jump to No. 8. Valdosta State retained the No. 9 place in the poll this week and DBU remains in the top 10 at No. 10. At the other end of the top 25, Concordia-St. Paul – who won a share of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference regular season title with Southwest Minnesota State and who will be the No. 1 seed in the NSIC Tournament that begins this week – returns to the poll at No. 24 and Miles makes its first appearance of the year in the No. 25 spot.
