



## National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

### 2023-24 Rankings – Feb. 27, 2024 (Poll #14)

Nova Southeastern began the 2023-24 season as the nation's top-ranked team and following a win by St. Edward's over No. 1 West Texas A&M, the Sharks have returned to the top spot in the new NABC/Division II coaches poll.

The Sharks, currently on a 10-game winning streak, moved back to No. 1 which it last occupied on Jan. 2. They are followed by Fort Lewis, which has reached its highest point ever in the ranking at No. 2, Minnesota State and West Texas A&M, whose two losses this season have both been by one point. Gannon held onto the No. 5 spot in the new poll.

The second five is headed by Northwest Missouri State, followed by Colorado Mesa, California (Pa.), MSU Moorhead and Charleston, who is in the top 10 in the coaches poll for the first time in 22 seasons.

Three new teams came into the top 25 in the final three spots – USC Aiken at No. 23, Cal State San Bernardino at No. 24 and Kentucky Wesleyan at No. 25. The Panthers have won nine games in succession and the school that has been ranked in more weeks than any team in Division II history is making its first appearance in the rankings since March 7, 2017.
