2022-23 Rankings – Feb. 28, 2023 (Poll #14)

Conference tournaments are in full swing around NCAA Division II and with Selection Sunday coming up, Nova Southeastern continues to hold the top spot in the latest NABC/Division II men's basketball rankings.

The Sharks begin defense of their Sunshine State Conference championship Tuesday as the only remaining undefeated team in Division II. This week's rankings are headed by nine teams that will take a top seed – either overall or within their division – into conference tournament play this week. In addition, seven of the teams that were rated first in their respective regions in last week's NCAA regional rankings are among the top 10 nationally this week.

The NCAA will release its third set of regional rankings on Wednesday, March 1 before the tournament selections are announced Sunday night. Winston-Salem State earned the first automatic bid by winning the Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association title and the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference title will be decided Tuesday between MSU Moorhead and Minnesota Duluth. The other 21 conference tournament will conclude this weekend.
