



National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2023-24 Rankings – Jan. 2, 2024 (Poll #6)

There were no changes among the top four teams in the first NABC/Division II men's basketball rankings for the 2024 calendar year, as Nova Southeastern was a unanimous selection at No. 1 and MSU Moorhead, Minnesota State and West Texas A&M all following the Sharks. The first change came at No. 5 due to Central Oklahoma's loss Sunday to Fort Hays State, allowing Saint Martin's to move up the fifth spot.

Due to limited action since the end of the NCAA Division II winter break, most of the top 25 remained intact this week as 24 of the 25 teams remained in the rankings. The only newcomer this week is Florida Tech, who joined at No. 25 on the strength of a 9-1 start to its campaign.
