



## National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

**2022-23 Rankings – Jan. 17, 2023 (Poll #8)**

The last two undefeated teams in NCAA Division II also hold the top two spots in the latest NABC/Division II rankings, as Indiana (Pa.) will spend its fourth straight week as the top-ranked team and Nova Southeastern remains at No. 2.

The past week, however, saw the teams ranked third, fourth and eighth all suffer setbacks, with 10 of last week's top 25 teams all losing at least once as conference play has reached full speed around the nation. Losses by Black Hills State and Northwest Missouri State has brought about a reshuffling in the top five, as Lincoln Memorial now sits at No. 3, Central Oklahoma – who handed Northwest its loss last week – at No. 4 and Colorado School of Mines moving up to fifth.
