

National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2022-23 Rankings - Jan. 24, 2023 (Poll #9)

The two remaining teams in NCAA Division II without a loss continue to hold the top two spots in the latest NABC/Division II rankings as the top five positions remained the same this week.

Indiana (Pa.) is ranked first for the fifth consecutive week and Nova Southeastern continues to hold onto the second position, while the other top five teams from a week ago – Lincoln Memorial, Central Oklahoma and Colorado School of Mines – all holding their spots in the poll as well. After those five, 11 of the next 20 teams in last week's poll suffered losses last week to shuffle the rankings and bring two new teams, Mercyhurst and Angelo State, into the top 25 for the first time this season.
