

National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2024-25 Rankings - Jan. 28, 2025 (Poll #10)

The top four teams in last week's NABC/Division II rankings remain in those spots this week, but the four teams that followed that quartet all suffered losses to bring about a reshuffling in the latest poll.

Washburn and Daemen, NCAA Division II's last two undefeated teams, remained in their positions this week as did Nova Southeastern at third and Alabama Huntsville at fourth. The losses that afflicted the teams that followed, however, brings Missouri S&T up to the fifth spot – its highest ranking in program history – and Valdosta State into the top 10 as well at No. 6. The remainder of the top 10 includes Fairmont State, DBU, Findlay and Lincoln Memorial.

This week's new entries into the top 25 – No. 22 Point Loma and No. 25 Saint Martin's – are back into the rankings after being among the ranked earlier in the season.

The schedule for the upcoming week is highlighted by matchups between No. 11 Lake Superior State and No. 15 Ferris State as well as Fort Hays State – among those receiving votes – taking on top-ranked Washburn on Thursday.
