Weekly Poll Notes:

March has arrived, the conference tournaments are in full swing and the NCAA Division II show is coming up on Sunday. With that, the top 12 spots are still the same in this week's NABC/Division II rankings with championship week now in progress.

Nova Southeastern remains at the top of the rankings for the fourth consecutive week and is still the last remaining undefeated team in Division II heading into the Sunshine State Conference Tournament, where it will open play against Florida Tech.

West Liberty remains in the second spot heading into the Mountain East Conference Tournament, while Indiana (Pa.) is third and Lubbock Christian is fourth. The fifth ranked team this week, Augustana, was knocked off in the semifinals of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Tournament on Monday by MSU Moorhead.

The Northern Sun title game will feature No. 12 Minnesota Duluth and MSU Moorhead to determine the second automatic qualifier for the NCAA Division II Tournament. Fayetteville State grabbed the first automatic spot after it won the Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association title on Saturday.

The other 21 automatic bids will be earned this weekend as conference tournaments conclude across the nation.

The NCAA is scheduled to release the last of its three weekly regional rankings on Wednesday, March 2 and the NCAA selection show will air at NCAA.com on Sunday night.
