

National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2023-24 Rankings - Nov. 28, 2023 (Poll #2)

Nova Southeastern is the unanimous No. 1 team in the NABC/Division II men's basketball coaches poll for the second consecutive week, as the Sharks won their only contest to extend their winning streak to 40 games. The top six spots remained unchanged, with West Liberty still at No. 2, followed by Central Oklahoma, Cal State San Bernardino, Chico State and Saint Martin's.

Three new teams entered the top 10 this week – No. 8 MSU Denver, No. 9 Minnesota State and No. 10 DBU – while Alaska Anchorage and Pace moved into the top 25 this week for the first time. Alaska Anchorage, whose eight wins lead all schools in NCAA Division II thus far, is in the rankings for the first time in a decade, while Pace is ranked in the coaches poll for the first time since Dec. 10, 2019.
