Weekly Poll Notes:

Lubbock Christian spent the week of Thanksgiving in Hawai'i and left the islands with three wins to retain the top spot in the latest NABC/Division II poll. The Chaps improved to 7-0 after knocking off the three Division II schools based in that state, including one over then-No. 19 Hawai'i Hilo.

Northwest Missouri State moved up to second and picked up a win over a ranked team itself when it downed then-No. 2 Truman State last Tuesday. Truman fell all the way to No. 20 due to that loss and one on Saturday at Upper Iowa, who became one of the five new entries in the poll this week at No. 19.

Eight of last week's top 10 teams stayed in that group, with Mercyhurst, Queens (N.C.) and West Texas A&M all moving up a spot to complete the top five. Nova Southeastern and Indiana (Pa.) each advanced two spots as then-No. 7 West Liberty suffered a loss at Notre Dame (Ohio) early last week. Fairmont State also moved up from 10th to ninth this week.

The two new teams in the top 10 are Chico State, who jumped up to eighth and Augusta, who is also off to a 5-0 start to reach the 10th spot in the poll. Right behind the Jaguars is Cal State San Bernardino, who made the biggest leap in this week's top 25 from 21st to 11th after an impressive win over last week's 11th-ranked team, Cal Poly Pomona.

The other newcomers joining Upper Iowa this week are No. 17 Minnesota State, No. 22 Barry, No. 24 Dominican (N.Y.) and No. 25 Miles. Dominican is ranked in the coaches poll for the first time since March 5, 2013, while Miles is among the top 25 in the NABC rankings for the first time in program history.

This week's top 25 includes three teams from the California Collegiate Athletic Association, Lone Star Conference and Sunshine State Conference, with 14 conferences being represented in the top 25.
