



# National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

## 2024-25 Rankings – Dec. 3, 2024 (Poll #3)

The top three spots remain the same in the first NABC/Division II men's basketball rankings for the month of December, as Nova Southeastern, West Texas A&M and Washburn remain at the top of the poll. West Liberty and DBU each moved up a spot as the result of Minnesota Duluth's loss to Lake Superior State, which vaulted the Lakers into the top 10 on the eve of a matchup against No. 6 Ferris State to open their conference schedule. MSU Moorhead, Daemen and North Georgia are the teams ranked between the two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference schools.

Four new teams entered the rankings this week – Minot State, Tampa, Coker and Cal Poly Pomona. The first three are among the 15 remaining undefeated teams in NCAA Division II, while Cal Poly Pomona is coming off a road win over Cal State San Bernardino on Saturday.
