



National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2023-24 Rankings – Dec. 21, 2023 (Poll #5)

The top three teams remained atop the final NABC/Division II men's basketball rankings for the 2023 calendar year, with Nova Southeastern staying at the top along with two undefeated teams from the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in MSU Moorhead and Minnesota State. The latter of those two picked up a first place vote this week after winning three times last weekend, including two over teams in last week's top 25.

West Texas A&M and Central Oklahoma moved into the top five, while a quartet of teams worked their way into the top 10. Meanwhile, three teams – Cal State Dominguez Hills, Post and USC Aiken -- are making their initial appearance in the rankings this week and Northwest Missouri State returns to the rankings after falling out last week.
