2025-26 Rankings – Feb. 10, 2026 (Poll #11)

Central Missouri's win over top-ranked Washburn Saturday has brought a familiar face back to the top of the NABC/Division II men's basketball poll, as defending national champion Nova Southeastern returns to the No. 1 position in the rankings for the first time since falling out of the top spot in December.

The Sharks, who have won 12 consecutive games and last five by an average of 37.2 points per contest, were not a unanimous choice as the top team as two other teams received first place votes this week. Washburn remained at the top in the eyes of three voters and Cal State East Bay, the last remaining defeated team in NCAA Division II after the Ichabods' loss on Saturday, was atop four ballots and moved up to second in the poll just ahead of Washburn.

The next three spots remained intact with Daemen at No. 4, Anderson in fifth and Gannon at No. 6 heading into this week's action. The next two teams, West Liberty and Fairmont State, will face off Saturday at West Liberty in the second meeting between the teams; Fairmont State won the earlier matchup on Jan. 10. Oklahoma Baptist and Eastern New Mexico round out the top 10.

All 25 teams that were ranked last week remained in the top 25 for this week. The closest team outside of the ranked group is Rockhurst, who has forged its way to the top of the standings in the Great Lakes Valley Conference.
