



National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2024-25 Rankings – Feb. 11, 2025 (Poll #12)

For the fourth consecutive week, the top four teams remain atop the NABC/Division II rankings as Washburn holds onto the top ranking and Daemen – Division II's only other undefeated team – staying at No. 2. Nova Southeastern stayed at No. 3 and Alabama Huntsville at No. 4 as well, while DBU moved into the top five this week in the fifth position.

Missouri S&T's loss Saturday at Upper Iowa allowed DBU to move up to No. 5 and dropped the Miners to ninth, as they were passed by Valdosta State, Lincoln Memorial and Colorado School of Mines. The 10th spot in this week's poll is occupied by West Liberty, with Mountain East Conference rival Fairmont State right behind the Hilltoppers at No. 11 heading into a head-to-head clash Saturday at Fairmont State. It is one of two matchups involving ranked teams on Saturday, as Lincoln Memorial hosts No. 16 Lenoir-Rhyne.

Only two new teams jumped into the top 25 this week and both are in for the first time this season. West Chester joined the rankings at No. 22 to reach the rankings for the first time in five seasons, while Concordia-St. Paul makes its first-ever appearance in the Division II rankings at No. 24.
