



# National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

## 2024-25 Rankings – Jan. 21, 2025 (Poll #9)

Washburn and Daemen, the last two undefeated teams in NCAA Division II, retain their spots at the head of the latest NABC/Division II national rankings for the second week in a row. Washburn, who moved into the top spot last week, improved to 17-0 with two wins in the past week and Daemen also picked up two wins, including one over nationally-ranked Gannon, to move to 16-0.

Nova Southeastern remained third this week, while Alabama Huntsville moved up a spot to fourth and Findlay rose four spots to fifth after a week in which five of the top 10 teams in last week's poll suffered losses. As a result, four teams – Lincoln Memorial, Colorado School of Mines, Missouri S&T and Fairmont State – all move up into the top 10 this week.

Chico State entered the poll for the first time this season at No. 17 on the strength of a 13-game winning streak, while Southern Nazarene rejoins the rankings at No. 25 after falling out last week.
