#### Notes:

Queens is in the Elite Eight for a second straight year after capturing the Southeast Regional title, the fourth straight for a team from the South Atlantic Conference. ... The Royals were involved in the two highest scoring games of last year's tournament, a win over California Baptist and a double overtime loss to Northern State. ... This year's version ranks 10th in NCAA Division II in scoring at 89.1 points per game, led by Shaun Willett's 19.7 per outing. ... Willett is the only player in the Elite Eight field averaging a double-double on the season (11.6 rebounds per game) and has a national-high 26 double-doubles this season. ... Lewis Diankulu is shooting 58.6 percent from the field and has a team-high 33 blocked shots, while Van Turner has made 113 three-point baskets -- fourth-most in Division II -- while making 45.4 percent of his long-range attempts.

#### Notes:

Point Loma, the seventh different West Regional champion in the last seven years, is making its Elite Eight debut in just its second NCAA Tournament appearance. ... PLNU, who has won the second-most games in a season in school history, brings one of the most experienced lineups to Evansville with four seniors and a junior who have started every game this year. ... The one junior, Daulton Hommes, leads the Sea Lions in scoring at 21.8 points per game and is the nation's third-best three-point shooter with a mark of 47.3 percent. ... Point Loma's 41.8 percent mark from beyond the arc is the second-best in Division II, while it is third in overall field goal percentage at 51.8 percent. ... The Sea Lions are also the only team in the Elite Eight averaging at least 10 more rebounds than their opponents; they have outrebounded their foes in 30 of their 33 contests this season.
