Minnesota State won the Central Regional championship game over Northwest Missouri State 43-42, a game that produced the lowest winning point total in a Sweet 16 or later game in the NCAA Division II Tournament since 1987 when the shot clock and three-point line were both in use. It was just the third game out of the 548 such games played prior to this year's Elite Eight where the winning team scored fewer than 50 points.
