2024-25 Rankings – Feb. 4, 2025 (Poll #11)

There were no changes among the top five in this week's NABC/Division II rankings and very minimal changes took place over the balance of the top 10, with two teams rejoining that group after spending time there earlier this season.

Washburn remains atop the rankings and Daemen is second as both retained their undefeated status through the weekend. Nova Southeastern stayed at No. 3, as did Alabama Huntsville at No. 4 and Missouri S&T at No. 5. The first change came at No. 6 as DBU jumped ahead of Valdosta State – who lost in overtime last Monday to Alabama Huntsville – with Lincoln Memorial, Lake Superior State and Colorado School of Mines rounding out the top 10.

Cal State Dominguez returned to the top 25 this week at No. 23 and the two teams that follow – Adelphi and St. Mary's – are in the rankings for the first time in over a decade. Adelphi is ranked for the first time since Jan. 5, 2010, while St. Mary's is making its first appearance in the top 25 since the final poll of the 2012-13 campaign.
