

National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2022-23 Rankings - Feb. 7, 2023 (Poll #11)

The top eight positions in the NABC/Division II men's basketball rankings remained unchanged this week – with Indiana (Pa.) holding the top spot for the seventh straight week – but change is on the horizon after IUP's loss Monday at Mercyhurst has left No. 2 Nova Southeastern as the only remaining undefeated team in NCAA Division II.

The rankings are based on games played through Sunday, so the Crimson Hawks' loss will not be reflected until next week. Meanwhile, Nova Southeastern – who finished last season without a loss until the national quarterfinals – will look to remain unbeaten when it takes on Florida Tech and Saint Leo on the road in the upcoming. While the Sharks are the last unbeaten team left, there are now three teams left with just one loss – IUP, No. 3 Black Hills State and No. 5 UNC Pembroke – as the regular season is down to its final three weeks. The NCAA will release its first set of regional rankings on Wednesday, Feb. 15.
