

National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2023-24 Rankings – Feb. 13, 2024 (Poll #12)

After surviving an overtime contest at Angelo State on Saturday, West Texas A&M remains at the top of the NABC/Division II coaches poll for the fourth week in a row after completing a sweep of four road contests with Saturday's win. The Buffaloes are now the 11th school in the last decade to have at least a four-week run as the top-ranked team in the NABC poll.

The top five spots remained the same this week, with Nova Southeastern ranked second, Fort Lewis third, DBU fourth and Minnesota State fifth. The first change came at No. 6, where North Georgia fell back following a loss Saturday to Columbus State, allowing the six teams that followed UNG – West Georgia, Gannon, MSU Moorhead, Colorado Mesa, East Stroudsburg and Northwest Missouri State – to all move up one spot to complete this week's top 11.

The only new team to join the rankings this week is Northern Michigan, who comes in at No. 24 and is in the rankings for the first time in almost exactly 24 years – the Feb. 14, 2000 poll was the last to include the Wildcats.
