

National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2022-23 Rankings – Jan. 3, 2023 (Poll #6)

With very little action taking place across the country as teams returned to their campuses following the NCAA winter break, there was little movement in the NABC/Division II rankings as the calendar turns to 2023.

The top 20 teams in last week's poll remained among the top 20, but there was one significant change near the top as last week's fourth-ranked team, Hillsdale, suffered a loss and dropped seven spots to 11th as a result. That leaves just five undefeated teams in Division II heading into the first week of January – the top four teams in the poll of Indiana (Pa.), Nova Southeastern, Black Hills State and Missouri-St. Louis, along with No. 18 Young Harris.
