

National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2023-24 Rankings – Jan. 9, 2024 (Poll #7)

Florida Southern ended Nova Southeastern's lengthy winning streak last week, bringing a new team – MSU Moorhead – to the top of the NABC/Division II men's basketball rankings for the first time in program history. The Dragons, who are 14-0 along with fellow Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference rival and No. 2-ranked Minnesota State, won two road games over the weekend to secure the top spot in the poll.

Nova Southeastern dropped to third and the next five spots went unchanged, with West Texas A&M still at No. 4 and Saint Martin's in the fifth spot. But due to a number of losses involving ranked teams last week, there was a shuffle in the rankings beyond the eighth spot and four new teams entered the poll as a result. East Stroudsburg, Cal State LA, Colorado School of Mines and Lander all joined the top 25. Cal State LA is ranked for the first time since Dec. 11, 2000 and Lander is among the top 25 for the first time since Jan. 6, 2015.
