

## National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2022-23 Rankings – Jan. 10, 2023 (Poll #7)

The top three spots remained the same in the new NABC/Division II men's basketball poll, as the last three remaining undefeated hold those spots in a week where a new team occupies the fourth spot in the rankings for the fourth straight week.

Indiana (Pa.) is at the top of the poll for the third straight week, followed by Nova Southeastern and Black Hills State; that trio comes into the week with a combined record of 40-0. The new No. 4 team is Northwest Missouri State, who took over that spot after Missouri-St. Louis fell from the ranks of the unbeaten with its loss at Rockhurst. The other team that entered last week without a loss, Young Harris, suffered its first loss on Saturday with a setback at the hands of No. 9 Augusta.
