2024-25 Rankings - Jan. 14, 2025 (Poll #8)

Washburn has resided near the top of the NABC/Division II national poll for the first two months of the 2024-25 season – and now has reached the pinnacle of the rankings for the first time since Jan. 27, 1992 as the new No. 1 team in the nation. The Ichabods moved into the top spot after Nova Southeastern's loss to Palm Beach Atlantic last week and winning twice to improve to 15-0 on the year.

Daemen, the only other undefeated team left at 14-0, rose to second in the poll and Nova Southeastern dropped into the third spot. Ferris State and Alabama Huntsville each moved up a spot this week as well to complete the top five. With five of the top nine teams in last week's poll suffering losses, the next five positions include three teams that were not in last week's top 10 in No.7 Pace, No. 8 Florida Southern and No. 9 Findlay.

Gannon, who was ranked in the pre-season poll but not since the regular season began, returns to the rankings at No. 21, while Southwest Minnesota State is back in at No. 22 and Palm Beach Atlantic at No. 23.
