Weekly Poll Notes:

Nothing changed among the top seven spots in the latest NABC/Division II rankings, but a change could be on the horizon following the results of Monday night's action. Bellarmine, who holds the top spot in the rankings for the sixth straight week, suffered its first loss of the season Monday when it fell in overtime to Indianapolis. Since games played on Monday do not factor into the week's rankings, the Knights – who were the last team in NCAA Division II to lose a game this year – will retain the top spot for the upcoming week.

Northwest Missouri State, who held the top ranking at the start of the season, remains second this week ahead of Lincoln Memorial, West Texas A&M and UC San Diego. St. Edward's and Indiana (Pa.) also stayed at sixth and seventh, respectively, with the first change coming at No. 8 with Nova Southeastern moving up.

The Lone Star Conference and Sunshine State Conference have two teams apiece in this week's top 10 after Florida Southern moved in at No. 9. St. Thomas Aquinas also makes its first appearance in the top 10 in the coaches poll since Dec. 27, 2016 at No. 10.

Dixie State and Queens (N.C.) return to the top 25 this week as two of the three new entries for this week. The third is Charleston at No. 21, who has reached the top 25 for the first time since Jan. 22, 2013.

The California Collegiate Athletic Association and Lone Star Conference are the only conference with three teams in this week's poll. A total of 14 conferences have teams ranked in this week's top 25.
