



National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2022-23 Rankings – Jan. 31, 2023 (Poll #10)

Indiana (Pa.) and Nova Southeastern -- the two remaining undefeated teams in NCAA Division II -- remained at the top of this week's NABC/Division II men's basketball rankings for the sixth straight week, but losses by the teams that held the next three spots last week as brought two teams back into the top five and another one in for the first time this season.

The three teams that lost games -- Lincoln Memorial, Central Oklahoma and Colorado School of Mines -- all dropped into the second five and moving back in are Black Hills State, who was third earlier in the season and Northwest Missouri State at No. 4. UNC Pembroke, whose 21 wins are tied for the most in the nation through Monday (No. 12 Point Loma won its 21st game Monday night), joins the top five in the fifth spot.
