Weekly Poll Notes:

Northwest Missouri State continues to lead the pack in the NABC/Division II national rankings as the Bearcats head into the final week of the regular season as a unanimous top-ranked team following a week where several ranked teams suffered losses.

Last week's second-ranked team, West Texas A&M, split a weekend set with sixth-ranked Lubbock Christian, which allowed Truman State to advance to No. 2, undefeated Mercyhurst to rise to No. 3 and Colorado Mesa to fourth in this week's poll.

Colorado School of Mines also jumped back into the top five this week at No. 5 and Northern State, who captured the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Tournament that concluded Sunday, rose two spots as well to sixth. Lubbock Christian edged out West Texas A&M for the seventh spot on the strength of an 18-point road win over the Buffaloes on Saturday after West Texas A&M ended LCU's undefeated run with a four-point win Thursday.

Two additional regular season champions complete the top 10, as Great Midwest Athletic Conference winner Hillsdale remained at No. 9 and Flagler, who took the Peach Belt Conference regular season title, enters the top 10 for the first time in program history.

A total of eight conferences have multiple teams in the rankings this week. Four of those schools hail from the Lone Star Conference, while three others represent the Gulf South Conference.

This week's poll has three newcomers to it, including two making their first appearance of the season. Lee returns to the ranking at No. 23 and is followed by the two new entries in No. 24 Hawai'i Hilo and No. 25 Georgia College.

The NCAA will release the regional tournament fields on Sunday evening at 10:30 p.m. Eastern time. All eight of the pre-determined regional sites have been announced by the NCAA.
