#### Weekly Poll Notes:

With conference tournaments moving into full swing, the last regular season NABC/Division II coaches poll finds the same seven teams at the top as it was a week ago. Northwest Missouri State holds the top spot for the sixth straight week and Lincoln Memorial, who owns the longest winning streak in Division II at 29 games, is second. LMU was the only team in Division II to record an undefeated season in conference regular season play.

The rankings currently have four one-loss teams – No. 3 West Texas A&M and No. 4 UC San Diego along with the two aforementioned teams – and a pair of two-loss squads in No. 5 Florida Southern and No. 7 Indiana (Pa.).

The Lone Star Conference is the only conference with two teams in the top 10 this week, while the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association is the only one with three among the top 25. A total of 17 conferences have teams ranked in this week's top 25.

Of the teams ranked in this week's top 25, 17 are also the top seeds in the conference tournaments that are taking place this week. Each of the top eight teams in the poll and 12 of the top 14 hold the top seed in their respective conferences.

The first automatic bid to the NCAA Division II Tournament went to Winston-Salem State, who won the Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association title on Saturday. The Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference will determine its champion on Tuesday night, while the other 21 conference tournaments will conclude on either Saturday or Sunday.

The final round of NCAA Division II regional rankings will be released on Wednesday. As was the case last week, six of the eight teams that were ranked at their top of their regions last week are currently ranked among the top seven teams in this week's NABC poll. The exception is No. 6 Azusa Pacific, who was behind No. 4 UC San Diego in the West region.

The NCAA Division II Tournament selection show will be aired on NCAA.com at 10:30 p.m., Eastern time on Sunday.
