2024-25 Rankings – March 4, 2025 (Poll #15)

With Championship Week around NCAA Division II now underway, the next-to-last NABC/Division II poll for the season finds the top four teams still at the top of the rankings, headed by the lone undefeated team in the nation in Daemen. The Wildcats completed a 25-0 regular season with a win over Roberts Wesleyan and will take its mark into the East Coast Conference Tournament this week.

Nova Southeastern, Alabama Huntsville and Washburn stayed in the next three spots, then there was some shuffling over the next few positions. West Liberty moved up to No. 5 and Columbus State to sixth, while the rest of the top 10 consists of DBU, Lincoln Memorial, Colorado School of Mines and Missouri S&T. Florida Southern and MSU Moorhead – who plays Tuesday for the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference title – rejoins the top 25 this week and Midwestern State makes its debut at No. 25.

The NCAA Division II selection show to unveil the field for the national tournament will take place Sunday at 10 p.m. Eastern time on NCAA.com. The final national poll will be released on Tuesday, March 11 prior to the start of the regional tournaments the following weekend.
