2023-24 Rankings – March 5, 2024 (Poll #15)

Championship week has arrived for the schools at the NCAA Division II level and defending national champion Nova Southeastern continues to head the NABC/Division II coaches poll in the days leading to conference championships being decided and the announcement of the regional selections on Sunday.

The Sharks extended their winning streak to 12 games last week and holds the top seed in the Sunshine State Conference Tournament that begins Tuesday night. This week's second-ranked team, Minnesota State, vies for the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference title Tuesday when it faces ninth-ranked Minnesota Duluth in the championship game.

The next three spots are held by Gannon, Northwest Missouri State and Colorado Mesa – who begins a run of three South Central region teams along with Fort Lewis and West Texas A&M. California (Pa.) is eighth this week, followed by Minnesota Duluth and DBU. Three new teams join the rankings in No. 22 Emmanuel – making its first appearance ever in the coaches' poll – No. 23 Indianapolis and No. 24 Walsh.

The final NCAA Division II regional rankings will be announced on Wednesday and the NCAA selection show will air on NCAA.com at 11 p.m. Eastern time on Sunday.
