## 2024-25 Rankings – March 11, 2025 (Poll #16)

Daemen, the last undefeated team in all NCAA divisions, heads into the NCAA Division II Tournament as the top-ranked team in the final NABC/Division II poll for the 2024-25 season. The Wildcats defeated St. Thomas Aquinas in the East Coast Conference championship game on Sunday to complete a 27-0 regular season and will open play as one of eight regional hosts this weekend.

Nova Southeastern and Alabama Huntsville, the second- and third-ranked teams respectively, head up the South Regional field with identical 30-1 records, while fourth-ranked DBU will serve as the South Central Regional host. Regional tournaments will also be hosted by No. 5 Washburn (Central), No. 6 West Liberty (Atlantic), No. 8 Columbus State (Southeast), No. 9 Point Loma (West) and No. 12 Missouri S&T (Midwest).

Regional play gets underway Friday with the West Regional, while the other seven regional tournaments begin on Saturday. The eight winners will head to Evansville, Ind., for the Elite Eight that will get underway on March 25.
