

National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2023-24 Rankings – March 12, 2024 (Poll #16 - Final)

Defending NCAA Division II champion Nova Southeastern will defend its title as the top-ranked team in the final NABC/Division II coaches poll, as the Sharks will bring their 27-2 record into the South Regional that they will host beginning on Saturday.

The top three teams in the poll – all two-loss teams – will host regionals as well, as No. 2 Minnesota State is the site of the Central Regional and No. 3 Gannon will host part of the Atlantic Regional that begins on Friday. No. 8 California (Pa.) will host the other half of the Atlantic Regional's first and second rounds due to Gannon also hosting the women's regional, while the other top 25 teams that will serve as regional hosts include No. 9 West Texas A&M (South Central), No. 14 North Georgia (Southeast), No. 17 Cal State LA (West) and No. 21 Indianapolis (Midwest). Saint Michael's, the first team outside the top 25, will host the East Regional

Regional action begins in the Atlantic and West Regionals on Friday, with the other six set to get underway on Saturday. The eight regional champions, which will be determined at the end of play on Tuesday, March 19, will head to Evansville, Ind., for the Elite Eight starting on March 26.
