2023-24 Rankings – Nov. 21, 2023 (Poll #1)

Defending national champion Nova Southeastern and the team it defeated in last year's title game, West Liberty, hold the top two spots in the first NABC/Division II national rankings. The first regular season poll looks quite a bit different from the pre-season poll as a number of the teams in that ranking suffered losses over the early portion of the campaign. A total of 12 new teams have found their way into the rankings heading into the Thanksgiving weekend.
