Weekly Poll Notes:

Northwest Missouri State remains atop the NABC/Division II poll and will look to extend its 44-game winning streak Wednesday when its hosts Illinois Springfield. The Bearcats have been ranked first in each of the last eight weekly polls dating back to last season.

There were no changes among the top five teams in the rankings this week, but losses suffered by sixth-ranked Queens (N.C.) and seventh-ranked Missouri Southern dropped the Royals and Lions out of the top 10. Alabama Huntsville and Southern Indiana make their first top 10 appearances of the season this week.

Monday's results are not factored into the poll but two teams ranked in the top 25 suffered their first setback on Monday. No. 7 Valdosta State fell at Union, while No. 16 St. Thomas Aquinas – who had just knocked off then-No. 23 Jefferson in overtime on Saturday – lost to unbeaten Dominican (N.Y.).

Four new teams are in this week's top 25, led by No. 20 Southeastern Oklahoma State who is ranked in the NCAA Division II poll for the first time since the final ranking of the 2006-07 season. Dixie State enters at No. 21, as does Dallas Baptist at No. 22 and Azusa Pacific at No. 25.

The Great Lakes Valley Conference and Gulf South Conference have two teams apiece in the top 10 (Bellarmine and Southern Indiana from the GLVC; Valdosta State and Alabama Huntsville from the GSC). The GLVC and Lone Star Conference have three teams apiece in the top 25, while six other conferences have two teams apiece.

A total of 15 of the 23 NCAA Division II conferences have representatives in this week's top 25.

Only one matchup of teams in the top 25 is scheduled for the upcoming week, which will take place Saturday when No. 7 Valdosta State plays at No. 24 Florida Southern.
