



## National Association of Basketball Coaches NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Rankings

2018-19 Rankings – Nov. 27, 2018 (Poll #2)

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – For the second consecutive week, Bellarmine was unanimously selected as the top-ranked team in the NABC/Division II poll as the top five spots from the first poll remained unchanged.

Bellarmino, who won its only game of the week by knocking off Wayne State (Mich.), picked up all 16 first place votes to retain the top position. The Knights were followed by Northwest Missouri State, Indiana (Pa.), Saint Anselm and Southern Nazarene to complete the top five.

The first change in the poll came at No. 6, where Valdosta State leapfrogged over Cal Poly Pomona – who was idle last week – while West Texas A&M remained at No. 8. The only new entry in the top 10 was Findlay moving up four spots to ninth following its victory last Tuesday over defending national champion and then-14<sup>th</sup>-ranked Ferris State.

West Liberty completes this week's top 10 and Morehouse – who loss to Miles Monday is not factored into this week's poll (only results through Sunday are considered) remained at No. 11.

Following Morehouse, there was plenty of movement in the poll, ncluding the entry of five new teams into the rankings among the final seven teams listed this week.

Barry moved up five sports to 12<sup>th</sup> and St. Cloud State, who picked up an impressive road win at Point Loma over the holiday weekend, rose to 13<sup>th</sup>. Barton also moved up six spots to No. 14 while Western Washington held at No. 15.

UC San Diego rose three spots to 16<sup>th</sup> this week, while Nova Southeastern and St. Thomas Aquinas both moved up five spots apiece to 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>, respectively.

The next two spots are held by two of the new entries in the poll – Indianapolis, who is off to a 6-0 start and Shippensburg, who is perfect through five contests to round out this week's top 20.

The last five teams in the poll this week are bookended by two teams that fell back in the rankings due to losses on Saturday, No. 21 Florida Southern and No. 25 Queens (N.C.). In between the Moccasins and Royals are USC Aiken at No. 22, Lenoir-Rhyne at No. 23 and Bentley at No. 24.

This week's national schedule finds a number of conferences beginning their league schedules, starting with a Wednesday night matchup between Barry and Nova Southeastern in the Sunshine State Conference opener for both teams.
