

UMR Miner Basketball Camp

Young players will learn the fundamentals and skills of the game as well as develop ideals in sportsmanship, leadership and citizenship.

The Camp: These camps are designed to teach fundamental basketball skills to young players entering grades 3 through 10 in Fall 2006 for girls and grades 3 through 8 for boys. An emphasis will be placed on the development of shooting, ball handling, rebounding, passing and defensive skills. Time will also be spent on footwork, pivots, balance and proper positioning. We will have 8 ft. goals for younger campers.

Camp Dates: June 12-15 for girls and June 19-22 for boys.

Equipment: Players must provide their own shoes. Each camper will receive a participation gift.

Contests: Campers will have the opportunity to participate in free-throw, hot-shot, three-on-three and one-on-one contests. Five-on-five games will also be a part of daily activities. Prizes will be awarded for all contest winners.

in the Main Gym of the Gale Bullman Multipurpose Building. Camp will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. and end at noon each day.

Camp fee is \$80.00/person; \$70.00/person for two or more per family. A \$40 deposit must be mailed prior to June 5th.

Health: All campers must have a physician's statement confirming their fitness for athletic activity. Physical records required by your school are acceptable. Insurance company name and policy number for health and accident is required for enrollment. (Please note any special medical conditions.)
