West Texas A&M, the top seed in the Elite Eight, is in the national quarterfinals for the third time in the last four years. The Buffaloes lost in the national semifinals to eventual national champion Ferris State in 2018 and lost to Southern Indiana a year later. ... The Buffaloes rank third in NCAA Division II in turnover margin, forcing 6.7 more per game than their foes

and are sixth in scoring at 91.6 points per game. ... West Texas A&M is one of three teams in this year's Elite Eight with two players that are averaging better than 20 points per game, with Joel Murray averaging 23.5 (ninth in Division II) and Qua Grant pouring in 22.5 a game after he scored 40 in the regional championship game win over Lubbock Christian.

Notes:

Daemen is in the Elite Eight for the first time in its third NCAA event; the Wildcats were named to the 2020 field before the tournament was canceled. Its only previous tournament game before this season was a loss to New Haven in 2019. ... Due to a late start to its season -- Daemen's first game didn't take place until Jan. 29 -- the Wildcats enter the quarterfinals with

10 wins, the fewest ever by a team in Elite Eight history. ... Daemen holds the eighth-best rebounding margin in the nation at plus eight per game, led by Andrew Sischo's 12.8 boards per contest that ranks third nationally. ... Sischo, the nation's fourth-leading scorer, had 12 double-doubles in 15 games this season, including a 25-point, 13-rebound effort in the East Regional final against St. Thomas Aquinas.
