Flagler is the first team to reach the Elite Eight in its first NCAA Division II Tournament since Azusa Pacific in 2015. ... The Saints have won their last 15 games; their other two wins came over Division I Central Michigan and North Florida in December. ... Flagler has held opposing teams to 39.5 percent shooting, the seventh-best mark in Division II. ... Jaizec Lottie, named

Player of the Year in the Peach Belt Conference, is the nation's seventh-leading scorer with an average of 24.7 points per game; he had 35 in the South Regional final against Alabama Huntsville for his eighth 30-point game of the season. ... Chris Metzger is second in the nation in field goal percentage at 73 percent.

Truman State is making its second Elite Eight appearance and first since 1999, when it fell in the semifinals to MSU Denver a day after a three-overtime win over Saint Rose. ... The 3-OT win in 1999 was the Bulldogs' last NCAA Tournament win until this season. ... Truman comes into the quarterfinal matchup as the 11th-best shooting team in the country at 49.9 percent. ...

Turner Scott ranks second in the nation with his 131 assists and had at least five in 17 of the Bulldogs' 22 games. ... Cade McKnight, the Player of the Year in the Great Lakes Valley Conference, had 21 points in the Midwest Regional championship win over Michigan Tech and scored six of Truman's last eight points, including the go-ahead basket with 4.7 seconds remaining.
